Dear Neighbor:

This has been a special year for McGregor as we have celebrated 50 years of service to the communities of Durham, Lee, Madbury, and UNH. Over the past half-century, we have grown from a single hearse-style ambulance to three state-of-the art ambulances. We have also seen requests for our service increase by tenfold. Thankfully, the generosity of you and your neighbors, coupled with our highly trained volunteers and a tight-knit staff, has enabled McGregor to sustain the high level of care that our communities have rightfully come to expect and deserve.

Although our operating expenses are covered partially by insurance payments and contributions from the communities served, **your** donation remains critical for keeping our equipment state of the art.

I ask you to consider the importance of having the best-trained and experienced first responders arrive along with the right mix of supplies and equipment during an emergency. The results of donations are seen on our streets every day and, if you need these services personally, it can indeed be a live-saving experience. Think of McGregor as insurance – there when you, your family, or friends need it; on-scene locally within minutes and ready to do whatever is necessary to relieve suffering and ensure the best possible outcome.

Please consider a special tax-deductible gift honoring our 50 years of service! All gifts are used to enhance the service offered to the community with upcoming purchases including:

- **Digital mobile ambulance radio = \$5,000 each.** Ensures seamless communication with other local responders who are increasingly utilizing this newer, digital, technology. Three are needed.
- **Video Laryngoscope = \$2,500 each.** Utilized to place breathing tubes in patients having the most critical medical emergencies allowing Paramedics to provide hospital-level airway visualization. Three are needed.
- **Controlled Air-Purifying Respirator = \$1,000 each.** Increases the safety of our volunteers and staff by filtering the air of highly virulent airborne diseases. Two are needed.
- **Automated External Defibrillators (AED) = \$750 each.** Distributed to our volunteers and Paramedics living locally allowing them to respond quickly in the event of cardiac arrest with this lifesaving and time critical treatment. Two are needed.
- **Blanket Warmer = \$500 each.** Helps to quickly warm patients and enhance patient comfort during the colder months by allowing us to provide pre-warmed blankets. Three are needed.
